

Enclosed in your file is the executive order sent out by Governor Strickland pertaining to travel and other expenses and a follow-up letter from J. Pari Sabety explaining the control guidelines for travel. Starting with the approved minutes from the January OAC meeting, all approved OAC minutes will be placed on the website, listed under commission info.

Enclosed is a copy of an article that was in the Lake County Gazette, pertaining to mixed martial arts events that were conducted in Lake County.

The Ohio Commission took part in selecting the new National database for mixed martial arts. This will be a similar format to Fight Fax but many more detailed features, such as: Color coded names that are suspended so they will not be overlooked; (2). A National ID number that will be good for between 4 and 5 years. ALL will expire on 12/31 of the 5th year. That means if a person purchases their ID in June of 2008 the license will expire in 12/31/2013; (3). Color coding bouts that are put in by commissions to separate from those that were not in the past. ALL bouts now will have to be turned in by commissions. No amateur event will be accepted if it's not from a commission or verified by the commission.

The UFC total gate and taxes were: \$2,242,430 taxes \$83,231.50. This will not reflect in the March deposit because the UFC has an agreement with Nationwide Arena that ALL monies are paid through the Arena.
