OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION

Minutes of the July 19, 2016 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission (“OAC”) held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers’ Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Executive Director Bernie Profato. Roll call was taken by Mr. Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Schuerger, Commissioner Stainbrook, Commissioner Patton, Commissioner Mancini and Commissioner Dr. Armile.
- II. The minutes of the June 14, 2016 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Dr. Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Licensure list was presented for Commission approval. Commissioner Dr. Armile moved to approve the Licensure list. Commissioner Stainbrook seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- III. Under unfinished business Mr. Profato provided information from Nate Tubbs. Mr. Profato recommended that Mr. Tubbs receive a conditional promoter’s license for one year with the stipulation that all time, medical and bout requirements must be met within the proper time. If all of the requirements are not met his license will be pulled. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the one year conditional promoter’s license for Nate Tubbs. Commissioner Dr. Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- IV. Under new business, Assistant Attorney General Walter McNamara informed the Commission that he has submitted his two weeks’ notice and has accepted a position with a law firm in the German Village area of Columbus. He introduced his replacement, Assistant Attorney General Rico Barrera.

Commissioner Mancini discussed his recent trip to Cuba and visit to the Havana Boxing Academy.

Chuck Nelson and Chuck Haskell presented information about the High School KO Drugs event. Commissioner Dr. Armile made a motion that the Commission will no longer regulate any boxing or MMA tournaments with participants under eighteen years of age because our statute restricts us from doing so. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

V. A Pro Boxing event in Toledo on July 22 promoted by Victor Green. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the event. Commissioner Dr. Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A Pro Boxing event in Youngstown on July 23 promoted by John Loew, Jr. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to approve the event. Commissioner Patton seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A Pro AM MMA event in Dayton on July 23 promoted by Scott Sheeley. Commissioner Stainbrook moved to approve the event. Commissioner Dr. Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

A Pro Boxing event in Columbus on July 30 promoted by Troy Speakman. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the event. Commissioner Dr. Armile seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

VI. The Executive Director's report was read by all of the Commissioners.

VII. There were no public comments.

VIII. Commissioner Patton moved to adjourn. Commissioner Dr. Armile seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
