OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION

Minutes of the April 11, 2017 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission (“OAC”) held at 10:00 A.M. at the Bureau of Workers’ Compensation, Garfield Heights, Ohio.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Acting Chairman Jon Stainbrook. Roll call was taken by Chairman Stainbrook. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Dr. Armile, Commissioner Patton, and Commissioner Mancini.
- II. The minutes of the March 21, 2017 meeting were first on the agenda. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Licensure list, with the exception of one nonofficial, was presented for Commission approval. One person on the list of nonofficials (second) is a tier two sex offender. Commissioner Patton moved to table the discussion of the one person on the licensure list until the next meeting. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved. Assistant Attorney General Brian Honen is going to research the licensing of sex offenders for the next meeting. Commissioner Patton moved to approve the rest of the Licensure list with the exception of the one individual. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
- III. Under unfinished business it was noted that the appeal results letters that were discussed at the last meeting were mailed to the fighters. Also under unfinished business, it was noted that Promoter Littlejohn’s mother has paid his bill with a money order. If he wants to renew his license he will have to appear before the Commission.
- IV. Under new business Commissioner Dr. Armile discussed Muay Thai and Jujitsu events held in Ohio. There are no taxes being paid to the State from these events. Assistant Attorney General Brian Honen will research the regulation of these events.

Commissioner Dr. Armile discussed the UFC event last weekend in Buffalo, New York. There was a fighter on the card with breast implants. The New York Commission did not want to let her fight. They have legislation for Boxing that you cannot fight with breast implants. However, they eventually let her fight because there is nothing in legislation for MMA. We need to have something in the rules regarding breast implants. The liability issue needs worked out with the Promoter.

- V. There were no events.
- VI. There was no Executive Director's Report. Judy McCarty mentioned that the office has two leased copiers. Assistant Attorney General Brian Honen said that one of the contracts has a year left and the other contract is new. He will contact ComDoc and see what they will do about breaking the lease before it is up.
- VII. There were no public comments.
- VIII. Commissioner Dr. Armile moved to adjourn. Commissioner Mancini seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved.
