OHIO ATHLETIC COMMISSION

Minutes of the February 9, 2021 meeting of the Ohio Athletic Commission (“OAC”) held at 10:00 A.M. at the Ohio Athletic Commission, 242 Federal Plaza West, Suite 405, Youngstown, Ohio 44503 via conference call.

- I. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. Roll call was taken by Director Profato. Present for roll call were: Commissioner Armile, Commissioner Patton, Commissioner Stainbrook, and Commissioner Mancini. Also present was Joshua Monroe from the Ohio Attorney General’s office and Judy McCarty.
- II. The minutes of the January 12, 2021 meeting were first on the agenda. A motion was made to accept those minutes. Commissioner Armile made a motion to accept those minutes. Commissioner Patton made a second. The commission unanimously voted to accept the minutes.
- III. Unfinished business
 - A. Director Profato discussed the MMA PRO/AM event that was held in Newark on January 30. He would like to limit the number of fights to fifteen at future events. Some of the fights at the January event had to be cancelled due to the curfew. Otherwise, that event went very well. Josh Monroe stated that he will wait to develop the list for license suspensions. The House Bill is not in effect until October 2021.
- IV. New Business
 - A. Director Profato stated that the Arnold Classic will possibly be pushed to September 2021. In March, there will be two MMA events in Newark possibly via Pay per view.
- V. Events: Newark MMA PRO/AM events on March 5 & 6, 2021 promoted by Troy Speakman. A motion to accept was made by Commissioner Armile. A second was made by Commissioner Patton. The commission voted unanimously to accept.
- VI. Executive Directors Report: emailed to commissioners discussing illegal shows and possible license suspensions. Director Profato reminded the commissioners to do their ethics training online.
- VII. Public Comments: Josh Monroe reminded the commission that the meetings will continue via conference call until further notice.

VIII. Adjournment: Commissioner Armile made a motion to adjourn, Commissioner Patton made the second. The commissioners voted unanimously to adjourn.
